On October 31, 2024, the Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University will host an international scientific and theoretical online conference on the topic “Mustafa Shokay and the Turkic World: Science and Ideological Succession in History”. The conference is held within the framework of the implementation of the scientific project No. AP19677780 “Ideal statehood of Mustafa Shokay: science from history, ideological continuity”.

The main purpose of the conference is scientific research and discussion of Mustafa Shokay's contribution to the Turkic world and national liberation movements, discussion of the influence of Mustafa Shokay's ideas on relations and cooperation between modern Turkic peoples, as well as the possibility of studying his heritage and rethinking it in a new historical and political context.

This conference contributes to the support of scientific research aimed at strengthening ideological succession, unity in the Turkic world, and the preservation and development of the common historical and cultural heritage.

To participate in the conference, you must submit an application by October 1, 2024 to the organizing committee. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject applications that do not correspond to the topic of the conference.

To publish an article, it must be designed in accordance with the following requirements:

The volume of the text should not exceed 4 pages or be in the form of abstracts. In the upper left corner of the text of the report, the index of the Educational and methodological complex should be affixed; the editor is WORD, the font of the text 12. the texts should be written in TIMES NEW ROMAN font, the interval is 1 (one). The dimensions of the bottom and top of the page are 2 inch, right - 1.5 inch, left - 3 inch. New row:1 inch, pages are not numbered.

Please submit the articles in paper or electronic form. The cited literature is placed in parentheses according to the ordinal number inside the article [1, p. 25] and placed in the order at the end of the article. An article that has not been completed in accordance with the requirements is not sent to the press, and is not included in the collection.

Writing an abstract (in three languages) is mandatory. The text written in Kazakh is an abstract in Russian and English, for texts written in Russian, there is an abstract in Kazakh and English.

Key words are mandatory and are issued in three languages: Kazakh and English, Russian. Keywords should contain 5-10 phrases. The given keywords should very accurately reflect the subject area of the study.

The conference can be attended by scientists, employees of research institutes, university teachers, doctoral students, undergraduates.
