Reports are provided in the form of a single file, typed in a text editor WORD. Page format: A4. Page margins: top - 2 cm, bottom - 2 cm, right - 2 cm, left - 2.5 cm. Font: Times New Roman (Times New Roman KZ), 12 pt. Line spacing: multiplier 1. Paragraph indent: 1cm. Align text: width. References are located at the end of the article.

Figures: in the text, the figure is located in the center, in front of it one empty line is left. Below is the name of the picture.

Table: the word "table" and its number are left-justified without indentation; on the next line, in the middle, have the name of the table - the font is bold. After the table - one empty line.

Text is not subject to editing and is the original. Collection of conference papers will be typed by direct copying. Therefore, we draw your attention to the need to submit materials in a carefully edited form in compliance with all the above requirements.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject the publication of reports that do not meet the content and design of the conference requirements.

The costs associated with arriving at the conference are at the expense of the participants.
