



Almaty Management University announces the admission of articles to the 8th issue of the scientific journal "Colloquium".

The journal is a scientific peer-reviewed periodical with open access. The purpose of the journal is to disseminate the results of scientific research of undergraduates, doctoral students and young scientists in the field of social, humanities and computer science, tourism and engineering, as well as to create a professional platform for discussing trends and forecasts in these areas.

Thematic areas of the journal are the publication of materials in the field of economics, management, finance, accounting and auditing, law, tourism and hotel business, logistics, urban studies, information and communication technologies, journalism and information, art. The journal adheres to an interdisciplinary approach to scientific research, which makes it possible to present scientific results at the intersection of different scientific fields.

The journal is focused on the publication of the results of master's and doctoral dissertations, and the results of research works of young scientists.

All articles are accepted in Kazakh, Russian and English to the e-mail of the journal - colloquium@almu.edu.kz.

At the same time, on the official website of the journal (<https://colloquium.almu.edu.kz/>), authors can find instructions for preparing articles and the latest issues of the journal.

The authors' articles are subject to mandatory plagiarism checks using the **StrikePlagiarism** system (the originality of the article must be at least 70%) and the double-blind peer review procedure.

The cost of publishing in the 8th issue of the Colloquium is **free**.

The journal follows the policy of information openness and availability of publications. The journal is published only in electronic format. Articles are posted on the journal's website in full-text access. We are committed to the conservation and sustainable use of the forest fund.

Articles are accepted until April 1, 2022. The journal will be published by the end of April 2022.

Terms of publication of the article

1. For publication, articles that have not been previously published by the author (s) (in printed, electronic and other sources) are accepted, which correspond to the thematic areas of the journal and are designed in accordance with the requirements (attachment). Subsequent publication of an article accepted for publication in other journals, including translations of the published article into other languages, is not allowed.
2. Articles are accepted in Kazakh, Russian or English.
3. The article must indicate bibliographic information in three languages (Kazakh, Russian, English): title, abstract, keywords (at least 3) and information about authors, including the following information - full name, affiliation, country name, and author's address (-ov) indicating the main author, who is the first author in the list of authors. The author is also indicated for correspondence, indicated by a sign (*).
4. The article should include the following sections: introduction, literature review, methods, results, conclusions and discussion.
5. The volume of the article (excluding the title, abstract, keywords, information about the authors) must be at least 2000 and no more than 3000 words. The number of co-authors of one article should not exceed 3 authors.
6. The recommended list of used sources should be at least 12 sources (articles, scientific works, manuals, etc.), of which 40% should be domestic and 60% foreign, the availability of relevant sources for the last 5 years is mandatory.
7. A literary review should contain a critical review of fundamental and topical scientific works of domestic and foreign authors on the issue under study. It is also necessary to show the reader that there is a gap in the available literature that the researcher must fill with his scientific work. The review should be problem-oriented, so a simple listing of existing works cannot be considered a complete review. If necessary, the author can go beyond the narrowly focused specific literature on the topic and consider scientific works from similar (close) areas.
8. For any previously published statement, the articles must contain a corresponding link to the source of information. The link to the source is made in the following format: author (s) → article title → article / journal / book title → output data (issue number, page, year of publication) in the language of the published article / journal / book
9. If calculations or calculations were made in the article, then the author (s) must provide scripts, indicate the software and / or libraries in which these calculations were made. If there are errors in the calculations, the article will be returned for revision.
10. No more than one article from one author or the same author as part of a team of co-authors is allowed per issue.

11. At the stages of working with an article, communication between the editorial board, the author for correspondence and reviewers is carried out via e-mail.
12. At the stage of consideration of the article by the editorial board and reviewers, as well as after its publication, the authors undertake not to submit this article for consideration for publication in another edition.
13. The editorial board of the journal considers the articles received from the author, organizes the work on peer review. The decision to accept the article for publication is made after the review procedure within two months from the date the article is submitted for consideration.

Borrowing and plagiarism

1. The editorial board checks the article for the presence of borrowed text using the anti-plagiarism system, access to which is provided by the university's subscription.
2. The degree of originality of the article must be at least 70%.
3. Articles containing more than 30% of the borrowed text are not allowed for consideration. In case of repeated non-compliance with the requirement to borrow the text, the article is not accepted.
4. When quoting, it is advisable to use borrowed fragments, consisting of no more than 5 consecutive borrowed words, no more than 50% of such fragments are allowed per document. In case of direct citation (no more than 10 words) and paraphrase, the presence of links to the source is required.
5. Self-citation should not exceed 3 (three) references to your work in one article.
6. If the authors, while writing the article, used works, articles, provisions, or quotes and statements of other researchers, then they must necessarily refer to the works of these scientists and correctly format the cited text in accordance with the requirements specified in the appendix. Plagiarism appears to be unethical and violates the principles of the AlmaU¹ Code of Research Ethics
7. In the event that a demonstrable fact (s) of a violation of the research and selection of the ethics of scientific research by AlmaU was found in an article published in a journal, the editorial board undertakes to withdraw a copy of the article in the journal issue.
8. The author (s) of the article, in which a provable fact of violation of the principles and standards of ethics of scientific research of AlmaU was found, are not allowed to submit articles to scientific publications of AlmaU for two years from the date of detection of the fact (s) of the violation.
